## 2018 - What's New?

### 01 JANUARY

Major ground works in the centre of the site for the office building and last residence block.

### 02 FEBRUARY

Two cranes with anti-collision technology will be swinging into action to build more superstructure.

### 03 MARCH

Construction of the first floors of the last residence and office building. Digging of a new large attenuation pond.

### 04 APRIL

Steel frame assembly on the events space building. Road construction and foundation piling on the south production building.

### 05 MAY

Foundation piling on the north production building and installation of the roof slabs on the office and events space building.

### 06 JUNE

Installation of precast panels for the office building facade on the events space building.
