As you serve in harmony with such direction, may you prove to be a blessing to others and enjoy a special blessing in return.

Your Watchtower Identification and Assignment card is valuable and should be kept in a secure place. It will be used in obtaining food tickets at conventions and any releases given to pioneers at special rates. If you should have to relinquish regular pioneer service at some future time, your identification card should be given to the congregation secretary for forwarding to the Society.

Be determined to keep an accurate record of your activity and to promptly turn in a report each month to your local congregation. The elders will appreciate this and so will the Society. We, of course, will continue to consider your activity and how well you are meeting the pioneer requirements.

Sharing the good news with others is strenuous but joyous work. It requires a self-sacrificing spirit. But in proving yourself diligent, you have opportunity to imitate Jehovah and his Master Worker, Jesus Christ.
