Dear Brothers:

**Re: Advance Medical Directive/Release**

In connection with the distribution of this Directive, the Society would like to remind you that this document should not be retained by someone who is disfellowshipped.

At the time you inform a person of his disfellowshipping, the disfellowshipped person should be asked to turn in his Advance Medical Directive/Release. Since it indicates that the bearer is one of Jehovah's Witnesses, the card no longer applies in the case of a disfellowshipped person.

If the individual is reinstated in the congregation, then a new card may be issued.

We appreciate that, at times, it may not be too easy to implement this but we would invite you to do what you can, bearing in mind each individual circumstance.
