Re: Use of *Please Follow Up* (S-43) form

Dear Brothers:

There is no doubt that the faithful slave wants us to do all that we can to further develop the foreign-language field. It is in this context, as of September 2009, that a number of adjustments have been made in the circuit structure.

Nevertheless there are one or two areas that need some refinement to bring matters more closely in line with the directions received from the Governing Body. One of these involves the role of the congregation multi-language coordinator. Many of these brothers have performed sterling work. However, from this time onward we would like the secretary to handle any work previously assigned to the congregation multi-language coordinator. Actually, in some congregations the secretary already serves as the congregation multi-language coordinator.

A further adjustment is in our use of the *Please Follow Up* (S-43) form. In the past we have suggested that this form may be used to locate any who speak a foreign language whether they are interested or not. However from now on we would like the S-43 form to be completed only when individuals manifest true interest. Publishers should give the completed form to the secretary. If the secretary does not know which congregation or group should receive the form or does not have the mailing address, he may either send the form to the branch office or telephone the branch office to obtain the needed information.

We are confident that you will continue to develop the foreign-language field in your territory. By following the direction that is now provided, we can be sure of Jehovah's rich blessing on our sacred service.—Heb. 13:17.
