Re: Return address when witnessing by mail

Dear Brothers:

As a reminder, the branch office's return address should never be used on any personal correspondence. This includes all letters and items of literature that are mailed to give a witness to interested people, to not-at-homes, or to those who live in inaccessible places. When witnessing by mail, use either your personal return address or the local Kingdom Hall address. Doing so will avoid giving the impression that your correspondence was sent from the branch office.—*be* pp. 71-73.
