Re: Kingdom Hall Assistance Arrangement annual contribution—2011

Dear Brothers:

Your 2011 annual contribution to the Kingdom Hall Assistance Arrangement would now be gratefully received.

The simplified funding arrangement operates as follows:

- Each congregation can donate £3.00 per publisher per year as the sole means of funding the arrangement.
- Each congregation should be responsible for making this donation **in their own name**, even where congregations share a Kingdom Hall.
- Where congregations have to have commercial insurance arrangements (because they hire a hall, their Kingdom Hall is part of a commercial building complex, or because the lease dictates the insurer) the usual donation of £3.00 can still be made, and then the congregation can forward the bill for insurance to the branch office for payment. This ensures that the burden of such insurance is shouldered equally.
- If the congregation is experiencing financial hardship a reduced contribution, as determined locally, would be much appreciated. Please send a brief note to the branch office explaining the situation for our annual records.

The purpose and operation of this fund is set out in the section of the *Kingdom Hall Manual* September 2009, entitled “Kingdom Hall Assistance Arrangement.”

We request that you send to us your contribution for this calendar year by March 31, 2011.

We praise Jehovah for his abundant spiritual and physical provisions and we thank him for the generous spirit that abounds among you. May we take this opportunity to send you our warm Christian love and greetings.
