Re: Branch relocation project

Dear Brothers:

We were all excited to see the recent video report concerning the approval of the Governing Body for the relocation of the Britain branch facilities. (If anyone missed seeing this, please see the coordinator of the body of elders to arrange a viewing. In addition, the following website is available if you wish to view the proposed development—[www.templefarmdevelopment.co.uk](http://www.templefarmdevelopment.co.uk).) Further to our letter dated August 27, 2014, regarding the branch relocation project, we are writing to provide more information about how to assist with the tremendous amount of work that needs to be accomplished. In the spirit of Psalm 110:3 we appreciate that so many are willingly offering to help with this landmark project. Some have asked how long donations will be needed, and we are pleased to inform you that this is a 5-year project to be completed by December 2019.

We clearly have a need for people with skills directly related to actual construction work, including planning and design, but we also require a large number of volunteers to help out in areas related to project support. This includes a multitude of tasks including, but not limited to, catering, housekeeping, cleaning, transport, and security. As noted in the video Warwick Update #1 on [jw.org](http://jw.org), many have been surprised to find out that their experience which is not directly linked to construction may be the very skill that the organization needs at the moment. As with the temple construction in Solomon's day, "you have willing, skilled workers to perform every kind of service."—1 Chron. 28:21.

If you are available and would like to offer yourself willingly, you should request from your Congregation Service Committee an *Application for Temporary Volunteer Program* (A-19-E Eu). If you have skills in a particular field, please attach a CV or compile a separate sheet detailing your qualifications and experience and attach it to your application form. The normal age qualification is for volunteers between 19 and 55. In the case of volunteers who are over the age of 55, but may have specific skills and experience that could benefit the project, please submit a summary of your expertise along with an application form.

At the start of the project there will be limited accommodation for volunteers. Therefore if any brothers or sisters within commuting distance of Chelmsford have rooms or property that could be used to house volunteers, we will be very interested to hear about this. Please submit any details in writing to the branch (or using the [jw.org](http://jw.org) Inbox feature for the attention of the Branch Relocation Department).

We take this opportunity to thank you for your enthusiastic response. We are sure that Jehovah will richly bless this project to provide consolidated facilities to the praise of His name. As with Solomon's temple, Jehovah "will be with you until all the work for the service of Jehovah's house is finished."—1 Chron. 28:20.
